#### Accommodation

Tables and chairs to accommodate 49 passengers and three crew. Fitted carpet and carpet tiles.

### Galley

400 litres overhead water tank. Gravity feed to galley and toilet basins. Small fridge, counter & sink, kettles tea/coffee pots, vacuum flasks, cups etc

### Refrigeration

Small galley fridge

### **Miscellaneous Galley Equipment**

Equipment to provide morning teas for 50 people. Place mats, Kettles, Cups, teaspoons, sugar bowls, milk jugs, vacuum flasks.

### **Engine Description**

2 X 150 HP Honda four stroke engines. Approx 2000 hours less than 50 hrs WOT Regularly serviced in excellent condition. Tilted out of the water when berthed.

#### **Mechanic Details**

Hydraulic steering, Seastar twin outboard 2 cylinder with dual engine fluid link. Anchor winch.

#### Tankage

Two externally mounted aluminium fuel tanks serve as the engine pods. Each has filler necks, filler cap and vents, emergency shut off valves and CAV filters to trap water etc. Each tank is a separate fuel supply for the engines. approx 250 litres each.

### **Electrical System**

2 Deep cycle marine batteries switchable to Port, Starboard or both via 150 Amp isolator switches. Spare deep cycle marine battery maintained fully charged for emergency use. Primary fuses, Isolators and batteries located in aft deck locker.

#### **Electrical Equipment**

Radio, remote spot light, GPS, Sounder, radio, Amplifier and speakers. Internal lighting, windscreen wiper, horn, reversing camera, running lights, anchor light, Engine gauges & floor lighting. 12V/240 volt inverter.

### **Navigation Equipment**

Programmable GPS with applicable charts. Compass and charts.

#### Radios

VHF hand held radio. Marine radio. Sony radio and CD player.

#### Entertainment

Sony CD player, Microphone, 12 volt amplifier and speakers. MP3 port and twin RCA inputs to the amp.

#### **Construction Details**

Catamaran Fibre Reinforced Plastic to Survey standard. Enclosed cabin with sliding windows and an aft deck.

#### **Deck Equipment**

Anchor, anchor chain and anchor winch. Boat hook, ropes and fenders. Life buoys and Karlie floats as per survey requirements.

# Steering

Seastar twin outboard 2 cylinder hydraulic steerin system. Helm pump is an axial Piston pump, front mount helm 4.9 turns lock to lock.

# **General Equipment**

Two Honda BF150 2354 cc 4 stroke, long shaft, outboard engines. Dual binnacle control at helm. Gauges with over temperature alarms, oil pressure alarms, low voltage alarms, litres fuel/hr, total hours, engine temps, RPM etc.controls at helm.

# Cargo Gear

Cargo racks fitted to back deck.

Regularly maintained. Hondas serviced by Honda mechanics. Last slip and major Service including anti foul and engines April 2018.

Built in 1997 by Nustar Catamarans. Initial Survey by Waterways (NSW) Surveyor A.I Blakelock 13 March 1997 Stability approved and Stability Book issue 27 March 1997 and is included in the current documents aboard ship. Waterways Authority vessel permit 21212 granted 8 May 1997 Queensland Transport Certificate 12305QE issued 2 June 1997 and has remained current ever since.









