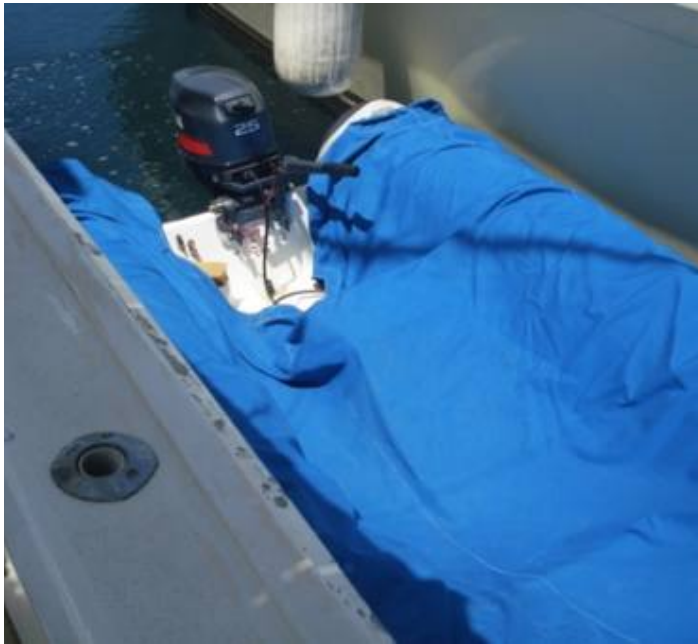
Air condition system needs to be maintained, as well as the electric system needs inspection and to fix anything wrong.
